Antiracist Identity Development	<p>In this workshop we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Discuss various theories associated with racial identity development ★ Critically reflect on our social identities and the ways in which these identities grant/deny social advantages ★ Outline principles associated with becoming an antiracist ally and co-conspirator
Antiracist Curriculum Reform and Development	<p>In this workshop we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Assess the current condition of our curriculum with regard to antiracism and equity objectives and outcomes ★ Explore models of antiracist curriculum integration ★ Example the principles associated with the Universal Design for Learning Framework ★ Develop a plan of action for re-forming our curriculum based on antiracist and equity objectives and outcomes
